Prof. Hademar Bankhofer in discussion with Prof. Dr. Klaus Jung:

Dermovital Therapy

The pain medicine of the future

A device that provides healing energy using activated oxygen from the air we breathe.

new device based on a totally new biotechnology is causing a stir internationally. It could both revolutionise and simplify pain control in the future, because it replicates natural healing processes. Prof. Hademar Bankhofer discusses it with Prof. Dr. Klaus Jung, Doctor for Internal Medicine, Sports Medicine and Naturopathy, who worked at Mainz University for 25 years.


This year we are experiencing a chaotic summer with both high and low temperatures, with extreme climatic changes between hot, cold and wet. This is particularly bad for people suffering from chronic pain. Some experience muscular pain, others suffer from headaches and migraines or struggle with sinusitis. In this situation many people resort to painkillers. However, this does not solve the problem. All they are doing is dulling the pain, not to mention the possible side effects of the medication.

A much more sensible approach is to activate the body's own self-defence and self-healing potential. Now: that is exactly what a new natural method is offering. This method has been developed by an innovative biotechnology company, based on its observation of Nature. A handy device that provides the weakened and painful areas of the body with specially activated oxygen with vital energy to promote healing. Some health experts have called this new technology the "medicine of the 21st century".

Bankhofer: There is a device for treating pain, based on a completely new medical technology. It is a hand-held device that is placed directly on the skin over the

painful or problem area. At first sight it looks like an infrared lamp or a heat lamp. How does this new technology work?

Prof. Dr. Jung: First of all: this new method of treatment - Dermovital Therapy – has absolutely nothing to do with infrared light or with frequency devices or magnetic field devices. This new device, the Airnergy Stream, is fitted with a special catalyst technology that artificially replicates a process known from natural photosynthesis. It activates the oxygen in the respiratory air. This releases an important energy, which is then transmitted directly into the body when the device is placed on the skin over the affected area. The crucial factor: the Stream device promotes the enhanced availability and utilisation of oxygen in the tissue and simulates increased production of endogenous protective enzymes in the cells and so reduces the concentration of free radicals – that is to say, of aggressive harmful substances from the environment and from the body's own metabolic processes.

Bankhofer: And so how is this able to control pain?

Prof. Dr. Jung: That is quite easy to explain: this extra energy supply from activated oxygen initiates or accelerates endogenous repair processes in the affected areas. And this can result in a direct reduction in pain and – this is an important point – in the elimination of its causes. And healing processes are accelerated. And all this without any adverse side effects.

Bankhofer: And how exactly do you use this device? I am thinking about its practical use, for example for knee problems?

Prof. Dr. Jung: You can treat the affected area of the body with the Stream device once a day by placing it directly on the overlying skin or even over clothing. However, usually it is a good idea to do it several times a day.

The usual recommendation is 3-5 treatments of 10-20 minutes per day. The device is convenient, light and ergonomically designed. There are virtually no problems in using it.

Bankhofer: How long do you have to continue this treatment until you notice a reduction in pain?

Prof. Dr. Jung: In some cases people notice the effects during the very first application, even if they had previously had no relief from other treatments. As a rule, treatment should be continued

until there is a clear improvement. That can take days or, in stubborn cases, even weeks. Natural treatments are just like any other medical treatment: you have to be patient, support the healing process and allow it time to take effect. One thing I would like to stress: the treatment doesn't only work on bare skin but also through clothing, leather, or even a plaster cast. And if you want to treat nasal or frontal sinus pain, the good news is that Stream energy will even work through bony parts of the body such as, for example, the top of the skull.

Bankhofer: So what can this new device treat? What are its areas of application?

Prof. Dr. Jung: That could be a long list because it is precisely this universal and yet targeted application that makes Airnergy Stream so interesting – so much so that, in my view and based on my experience, every household should have one. Let me give you some examples to illustrate this: for joint problems in the knee, elbow, fingers and wrists but also the feet. Also for muscle pain, sprains and strains, bruises and contusions and even for broken bones and injuries.

Good results can be expected for headaches, migraines and menstrual problems, sinusitis, ear infections and toothache. It is also effective for skin problems such as wounds, ulcers, scars and for cosmetic problems such as cellulite or as an anti-ageing treatment for the skin. Even smokers use it to treat their coughs and to help clear their lungs and respiratory tract. A lot of people even use

the device successfully on their beloved pets. All this is possible by supplying bioenergy via the skin. Because energy is an important natural remedy that helps us to regain our health and stay healthy.

Bankhofer: And how does one obtain such a device?

Prof. Dr. Jung: The devices are exclusively manufactured in Germany and delivered to more than 70 countries. This technology has already won many international awards. Many doctors and therapists recommend Dermovital Therapy using the Stream device to their patients, thereby supplementing their previous treatment programme. How to use the new Stream device correctly:

- ➤ You can treat the affected area of the body with the Airnergy Stream between one and five times a day. The treatment time varies between 1 – 20 minutes as required. The device is simply placed on or held against the affected area.
- ► The Airnergy Stream device can be used for joint problems, notably in the hips, knees, shoulders, elbows, toes, feet, fingers, hands or spine.
- ► It can also be useful to relieve headaches and migraines.
- ► It can be used for bruises, contusions, sprains, strains and burns.
- It has also proved beneficial for middle ear infections and other ear problems, as well as for eye problems and sinus problems.
- Other possible applications: toothache and jaw pain, throat irritations, skin disorders and menstrual problems.
